ADRC Adult Protective Services

Chippewa County is responsible for providing Adult Protective Services to the residents of Chippewa County. Adult Protective Services investigates allegations of abuse to adults at risk and elder adults at risk.

Referrals for investigations by protective services may be received from community agencies, family members, and law enforcement.

Protective Services needs may include emergency situations -- housing issues, medical crises, need for food or assistance with heating and energy costs -- that create an immediate safety risk for an individual that cannot remedy the situation with other available resources or options.

Staff will provide links to resources to help keep vulnerable adults safely independent in their homes. This may include services from nutrition programs, medical providers, and agencies that provide in-home services.

ADRC Chore Service Program

ADRC Guardianships / Protective Placements

Chippewa County provides assistance with guardianships and protective placements for residents of Chippewa County. Financial guidelines may apply to receive assistance for these services.

A guardianship is a relationship between a ward, one who the court has determined to be incompetent in making his or her own medical and/or financial decisions, and a guardian, who the court authorizes to make those decisions on behalf of the ward.

ADRC Nutrition

Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels provides a hot meal delivered right to a person's door. Meals on Wheels is for individuals aged 60+ who are essentially homebound due to illness, disability, or isolation permanently or temporary.

- Eligibility is based on a nutrition assessment.
- Noon meals are delivered by volunteers Monday-Friday.
- Donations are encouraged and appreciated. Suggested donation of \$4.00 per meal.

The ADRC is a referral resource for transportation opportunities and financial assistance for those eligible (co-pays may apply). A person needs to meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Ages 60+
- An adult with a temporary or permanent disability
- Reside at home
- No access to transportation
- No funding sources to provide transportation

<u>Vehicle modification</u> grants are available to meet a person's accessibility needs using a person's own vehicle.
